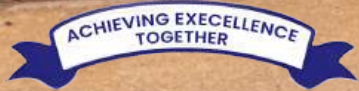
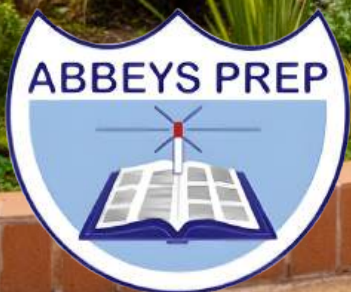

- Fostered partnerships with parents and the community, recognizing that education is a shared journey.

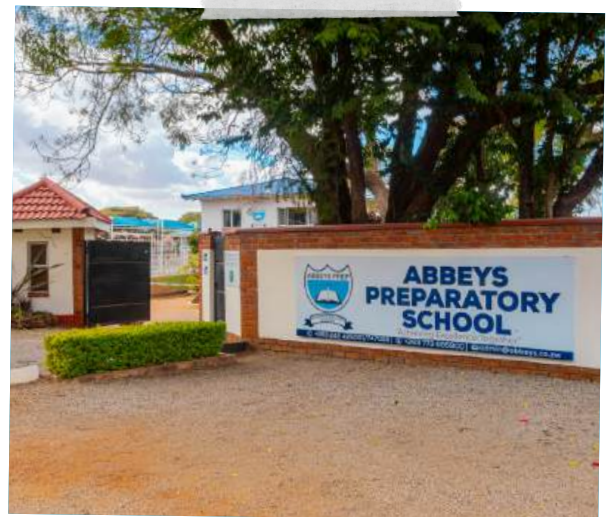

A New Era in Education

Abbeys Nursery School (then known as Annes Day Nursery) started operations in 1971. It later changed its name to Abbeys Day Nursery in 1999 when it was acquired by its current owners. The Preparatory School opened its doors for the first Grade 1 intake in January 2012 with only 8 pupils (5 girls and 3 boys)



Humble Beginnings

The school's journey began with a small group of dedicated educators and a handful of eager students. The first Grade 1 Class was housed at the Nursery School premises in Eastlea. The school has seen tremendous growth over the years and today there are over 600 pupils



A New Home & Expansion

Recognizing the need for expanded facilities to accommodate growing enrollment, the school migrated to its present home during the third term of 2013. As Abbeys Preparatory School continues to grow and evolve, it remains steadfast in its mission to provide quality education and inspire future generations. 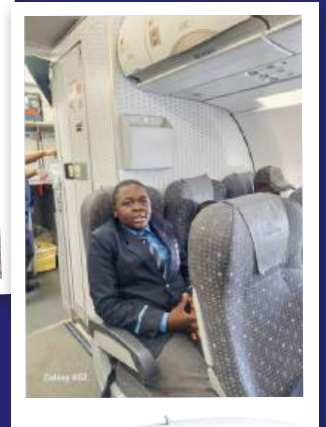
Abbeyans Explore Namibia
